

# **Population Projection For The City Of Saharsa**

Population projections are estimates the total size and composition at future dates. The assumptions involved in the population projections are always subject to much more doubt than those for population estimates. This may involve events which may have not yet taken place occasionally. They are reliable indications of the nature of the assumptions on which a population protection should be based. More commonly, the range of possibilities for each known factor which may influence one or more of the components of population change is so great with hidden factors numerous, that the selection of the basic assumption from among those which are possible may be little more than an intelligent guess. For this reason, two or more projections are commonly prepared on the basis of different set of assumptions so that the user may take the usual probable developments into account or may select the estimates based on the single set of assumptions best suited to his own needs. The word projection is used instead of prediction or forecast because the results are expected to hold true only to the extent that the assumptions are fulfilled.
