

# **Trends Of Population Growth In Buxar District**

In population geography the term 'Growth of population' is used in its broadest connotation to cover change in population numbers inhabiting a territory during a specific period of time, irrespective of fact whether the change is positive or negative growth of population is an interplay of three factors namely fertility, mortality and immigration. The balance between birth and death rate is called natural increase and difference between immigration (in migration) and emigration (out migration) is called migration.

The present study of population growth in Buxar district clearly points out that the growth has not been uniform rather there has been fluctuations in decadal variation. There has been also great range of variation in growth trend of population in different parts of Buxar district during different decades. Thus, the study of temporal and spatial variation in growth of population is apparent and it may useful for regional planning.
