

Micro teaching and its importance

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Micro teaching is an essential part of teaching. Without this mode anyone can not know and the depth of teaching. Such as the air is most important thing for the human life as the same, micro teaching is also most important for the teaching. This teaching is very important in all languages. without the knowledge of this teaching every teacher feels the some lack in himself. Micro teaching is the foundation of well teaching mode.

Micro teaching is originated in United States in Stanford University California and flourished from there in the whole world. Micro teaching is a training technique whereby the teacher reviews a vide tape of the lesson after each session. It is invented in the mid 1960 by Dr. Dwight W Allen, Micro teaching has been used with success for several decades now, as a way to help teacher technique new skills. This mode is a teaching technique in which a teacher teachers a small unit to group of five pupils for a small period of 5-20 minutes. In such situation a teacher acquires a new teaching technique. Micro teaching is to help a student to improve his own teaching.

Micro teaching is organized as practice teaching. Many teachers from the same or similar courses can participate in a single micro teaching session. While one person takes his turn a teacher everyone else plays the roles of the students. Micro teaching importance shows the highest personality of a teacher. District level officers in education department manage to train the employees for better education. This teaching is the way of such education by which a person can get the knowledge in a very short period easily. In other words we can say that this teaching is the base of well education. Any teacher cannot achieve the greatest goal without the use of micro teaching. A man becomes a find Doctor, an Engineer, a Philosopher, a Scientist etc because of this education.

The person, who has not the knowledge of this teaching, cannot fulfill the criteria of well education.

Micro teaching is a teacher technique currently practical worldwide. The skills of micro teaching such as presentation skills help the novice teachers to learn the art of teaching at ease and to the maximum extant.

In the original process a teacher is asked to prepare a short lesson for small group of learners, who may not have been their own students. This is videotaped. Seeing the video and getting comments from collegues and students provided teachers with an often intense under the microscope view of their teaching. Micro teaching sessions are practice teaching sessions, where instructors present short lesson to small group of peers and receive detailed feedback on their performance.

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
